Scope: Greentree Student Ministry exists to see students' hearts captivated, cultivated, and challenged by the Gospel of grace. Under the guidance of the Discipleship Pastor, and alongside the Director of High School Ministry and the Director of Middle School Ministry, this person works to fulfill this mission by seeing students grow in Christlikeness. This position is focused on ministering to female students.

People Development - 40%

- Help lead the student ministry team. Recruit, develop, and disciple volunteer leaders and interns.
- Develop and cultivate discipleship relationships with believing students. Spend 1-1 time with them and help them grow in their sanctification.
- Intentionally pursue, develop, & nurture relationships with nonbelieving and unchurched students.
- Pursue evangelistic relationships with students and encourage other leaders to as well.
- Foster a community that is outward-facing and welcoming to all types of students.
- Help form a culture where students serve those in the ministry, as well as those outside in the surrounding community.
- Prioritize relationships with students' families and their role in students' growth & maturity.

Program Leadership and Development - 40%

- Help cast vision and provide strategic leadership and direction for the student ministry.
- Help lead long-term and short-term planning and programing efforts.
- Regularly evaluate the ministry's programs, infrastructure, and goals.
- Engage in both the High School & Middle School ministries' programing efforts, including:
 - Student Sunday Schools
 - Weekly Youth Group gatherings
 - Special Events
 - Retreats, Camps, & Missions Trips
- Help lead the ministry's teaching and small group programs – including teaching in these settings and leading small groups.

Communication Processes - 20%

- Maintain regular and effective communication with students, families, and volunteers.
- Coordinate with other GTCC ministries and staff to enhance fruitfulness and effectiveness.

- Strong administrative skills and organizationally minded.
- People-oriented, engaging, and able to form relationships with many different types of people.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
